

YOU WERE ARRESTED DURING THE PROTESTS, NOW WHAT?

If You were issued a Desk Appearance Ticket (DAT):

- Call the National Lawyers Guild (NLG) at 212-679-6018 and give them the date & time of your court appearance.
- You MUST be in court on the date & time in the DAT.
- Get there at least 30 minutes early so you have enough time to get through security.
- This is NOT your trial date.
- Pro-bono lawyers with the NLG will be there to help you.

If You were already Arraigned (saw a judge):

- Call the National Lawyers Guild at 212-679-6018 and give them the date & time of your next court appearance.
- Go to court on date & time given to you at arraignment. Be there at least 40 mins early to go through security and talk to your lawyer.
- This is NOT your trial date.
- The National Lawyers Guild will work to find cheap or free attorneys for all arrested.

Be aware that statements made on the internet, videos and photos shared or posted are public domain and may hurt you or others in their court proceedings. Talking to the media, sending emails, posting tweets, facebook updates, etc. about your case or about your arrest, or that of others, could put you and others at risk. Please consult your lawyer before making any public statements. If you use a private attorney, please still keep in contact with the National Lawyers Guild. We want to approach this collectively as a movement in solidarity with one another to make sure no one is singled out for harsh treatment.
